Recently a number of all terrain vehicles have been seen operating inside the boundaries of our quarry in Lower Cove on the Port au Port Peninsula. A number of these vehicles have been observed by our employees driving at high speeds in areas where there is heavy equipment operating and on one occasion within thirty minutes of a planned blast.

Atlantic Minerals would like to advise the general public of the significant risks that exist within the boundaries of our limestone and dolomite quarries. Blasting occurs in Lower Cove from April to December, which creates a greater risk for unauthorized personnel. Only authorized individuals are permitted access to our quarry. There is increased danger for individuals who operate all terrain vehicles within our operation given the landscape and the size of heavy equipment operating in the area. We want to ensure the safety of all individuals entering our property as well as the safety of our employees working in Lower Cove.

Any individual who has a legitimate need to enter our property is required to obtain approval by first checking with the Security Office at the Main Gate in Lower Cove. We ask for the co-operation of the general public regarding this important safety measure.

Atlantic Minerals Limited is a world-leading producer of chemical grade limestone, chemical grade dolomite and construction aggregates. Our quarry located at Lower Cove on the Port au Port Peninsula in Western Newfoundland operates on a seven-day per week and twenty-four hour per day schedule for the majority of the year and employs approximately one hundred and fifty staff.
